## **Old Business**

- Weed Remediation President Saari
  - One quote from River City to spread granular chemical in the spring for \$14,577
  - Cal mentioned the Corp of Engineers seem to be against the organization spreading chemical but is okay with homeowners doing it themselves
  - One quote to harvest weeds for \$7000
  - Homeowners would like explanation on difference between harvesting and chemical
    - Misty Waters had River City spread granular chemical and they do not have a problem at all this year
    - Which harvesting are we looking at
      - Rake or cut



- TJ Toos spread granular chemical in Lakewood
  - Look into effectiveness
  - Ask TJ to provide a new quote
- Must have approval from membership to spend over \$500
- Rob Knoll made a motion to approve spending up to \$15,000 for weed remediation in Spring 2025
  - Cole Bertsch seconded the motion
  - Vote: 19 Yes 2 No
